LET'S GET THIS FIXED!

Last month our active membership for the year to date was down to 211 as reported in our monthly bulletin. However, by the time of our BEC meeting it was reported that we lost an additional 3 members so we were actually down to 208. Since then we have lost an additional member so we're now down to 207 as of March 28. At our April 12th luncheon we expect to install 2 new members so we're moving in the right direction. However, this means in order for us to meet the SIR State goal of +1 over yearend 2015 (i.e., 223) we still need 14 more new members.
