By the time you read this, our annual SIR family picnic will be just around the corner at a new location: Indigeny Reserve (see Danny's Little Sir Notes for directions). Note: The cutoff date to purchase tickets to the picnic was July 31, 2016. However, Danny has planned to have a number of extra meals available so you can purchase tickets at the 'gate'.

At our July branch luncheon meeting, I announced an upcoming event for our members and their significant others: On September 16 our three local branches will be hosting a musical event at the Elks Lodge. From 7:00 pm to 10:00 pm we will be having an evening of 'Fabulous 50's DJ Music' with lots of dancing. Also included will be 'Karaoke' for those Frank Sinatra wantabees to show off their skills. The cost is only \$10 per couple (\$5 if you are coming single). And, we'll have a cash bar with low cost drinks & sodas.

I will be bringing a 'sign up' sheet to our annual picnic for those of you that would like to attend. So let's get out of the house for a great evening with our fellow branch members and have fun!

A Special Note for Sponsors of Guests: All guests that have submitted an application for membership are welcome to attend the 'Fabulous 50's DJ Music' event. For the sponsors of these guests please let them know about this.

In July our active membership for the year was 213. However, in August it will be reported that we have lost an additional 5 members: Len Ruoff passed away, Ed Limon requested inactive status and 3 members (Lively, Nix and Silver) lost their membership for failure to pay their 2016 dues so we're currently down to 208. While you might think it's very harsh of us to drop members for not paying their dues it is through these payments that we are able to survive. Our member luncheons are essentially a break even event after we pay the caterer and the Elks Lodge for setup and renting the room.

Note: On the downside: The goal I was given by our State SIR President, Don Dill, is to achieve a +1 in membership by the end of the year. With a current active membership of 208 that means we need 15 new members (and no further attrition) if I am to meet my goal. Without your help, I'm in serious trouble. I'm not looking forward to hearing 'You're Fired'! We make a few bucks on the 50/50 drawing and that's about

it. The money from the dues pays our quarterly assessment for each member and our administration costs (printing and mailing bulletins, etc.) A large portion of the monies received goes to our special events - to subsidize the special dinners in order to keep member cost down.

An another subject - New Activities - please see the bulletin insert for our Combined Activities. We now have contacts for 4 new activities: Wine Tasting, Poker, Bocce Ball and Car Club.
