December will be fading away soon and my year as Little Sir for Branch 136 is drawing to a close. It has been a very busy but enjoyable year. I hope that you feel that I've done a good job and there are no regrets. By the time you read this our annual Christmas Luncheon will be upon us. I'm looking forward to another special event with great camaraderie, music and a fine meal. Our branch has been very successful this year in not only meeting but exceeding our State SIR president's mandate of "Plus One" in our membership. Having started the year with 219 active members, losing 21 and gaining 24, we're ending the year with 222 - an increase of 3 members. Thanks to many of you for bringing guests that became members.

On Nov 19th I held a Planning Meeting with all of our officers and directors to discuss plans for next year. I'm glad to report that at our January luncheon meeting we will be announcing implementation of many new things: A member satisfaction survey developed by Paul Squeri, Member Relations Program Director, to understand if the BEC is providing the type of atmosphere and activities that you want and to identify any problems areas that need to be addressed. A Membership Growth Program Director, Rex Page, that will have a supply of SIR tools (cards, brochures, etc) available for members to obtain and pass out to their friends and neighbors. Rex will also be distributing various items to local businesses to gain visibility for our branch. Note: On average our branch is losing 25 members per year through attrition. We must ensure that we bring in new members if we are to survive as an organization. Several new 'activities' being developed by Jeff Phillips, Activities Program Director, that will be available for both members only and members and their significant others. A new Theater/ Dinner program being developed by Monty Youngborg, Theater/ Dinner Program Director, that will offer a couples matinee outing to a local theater. A follow up dinner at a local restaurant will be offered for those that wish to participate. This will start out as a small group, 5 to 6 couples, in order to understand if it will be successful. A faster luncheon check-in process to ensure that all members are correctly identified so as to get credit for attending. Several other new things are under consideration and in the final stages of planning to see if they are viable to our branch so stay tuned.

The first big thing you will notice next year is a return to a 'Head Table'. This is being done to ensure that your officers and directors are readily available for any discussions you would like to have with them. Also, any guest speakers we have can be approached directly without interrupting any table discussions.

Secondly, all officers and directors next year will wear a silver color membership badge instead of a gold color one. This change is to make them more visible to all members, especially new members, and to better open lines of communications with them. In point, if any of our members have a suggestion, complaint, or anything else that needs to be addressed - find a 'silver badge'. This is your BEC and they are charged with taking ownership and having it taken care of.

On a final note, our Christmas Luncheon quota of 200 tickets has been reached. In fact, I have one more couple on a space available list if something should open up. In regards to this if you can carpool with another couple it would benefit any parking problems we may encounter and be very much appreciated.
