Hello again fellow car enthusiasts. Lately we've been enjoying some very mild weather this winter. My guess is many of you have pulled your weekend cars out during this break for a nice drive. Have you checked your tires lately? It's been rather cold on the morning and ill bet many of you have low air pressure readings right now. We all know low pressure contributes to poor handling as well as poor mileage. It can even cause premature damage to your tires. Remember your tires are part of your suspension. Your car needs that air cushion to safely navigate those potholes and other obstacles. Most cars have the tire pressure recommendations in the driver's side door jam. If you don't know most tires today recommend 32-35 psi cold. Also do a tire inspection. Do you see any small cracks in the side walls? Typical tire life is 6-10 years. A properly stored car in a garage can get several years longer but to play it safe I would recommend 10 years as the max life span. So let's all get out and safely hit the road.

How to Get SIR's Merchandise Sales

Unless you order directly online, select the item you wish to order and fill out the Abbreviated SIR's Merchandise Order Form in duplicate for each item. Forward your completed Order Forms, along with your check, to me by mail at the address shown or hand deliver it to me with your payment at our meeting. The second copy of the Order Form will be your receipt. As we do not have a Branch credit card, I will have to use my personal charge card to pay for the orders.

Because shipping and handling charges apply for orders below \$50, I will have to hold orders until that threshold is met. To avoid too long a wait time, we will take orders periodically, say every three months (February, May, August and November). Reminders will appear in the bulletin and be announced at the meeting preceding the order month.
