## How to Get SIR's Merchandise Sales

As we have announced, the Branch will no longer be stocking merchandise. That does not mean that you will no longer be able to get shirts or other items with the SIRs logo, branch or even your name embroidered.

Rather than having the merchandise on hand, you can select items from a catalog available at a table at our meetings. For those of you having computers, you can also go the Branch 136's web site and find the catalog online. Of course, you can always go to <a href="https://sir.ourproshop.com">https://sir.ourproshop.com</a> and view and even buy the items (if you want to buy directly, make sure that your order exceeds the free handling and shipping threshold).

Unless you order directly online, select the item you wish to order and fill out the Abbreviated SIR's Merchandise Order Form in duplicate for each item. Forward your completed Order Forms, along with your check, to me by mail at the address shown or hand deliver it to me with your payment at our meeting. The second copy of the Order Form will be your receipt. As we do not have a Branch credit card, I will have to use my personal charge card to pay for the orders.

Because shipping and handling charges apply for orders below \$50, I will have to hold orders until that threshold is met. To avoid too long a wait time, we will take orders periodically, say every three months (February, May, August and November). Reminders will appear in the bulletin and be announced at the meeting preceding the order month.


