- c) First score bowled in each event will count for All Events prize.

3. Handicap:

100% of 230 singles; 460 doubles

4. Average:

- a) 2019-2020 USBC Standard Composite Average.
- b) If none use USBC 2018-2019 Standard Composite Average.
- c) If none, current league average of 21 games or more, must supply secretary-signed current league sheet at check-in. If not any of these, bowler must use a 230 average (NO HANDICAP).
- d) USBC Rule 319a. 1-4 will apply. (If any current league average of 21 games or more is 10 or more pins higher than submitted, you must declare).

5. Verification:

If averages (per this Tournament Rule 4) are on the USBC League Average site (Bowl.com), no further verification is required. Averages and USBC membership will be checked prior to start of tournament.

6. Divisions:

There will be two divisions: Divisions 1 and 2 will be divided by average after mail-in close of entries.

7. Prize Fund:

Will be returned 100% on a ratio of at least 1 prize for each 4 entries.

8. Deadlines and Entry Requirements:

Entries mailed must be received by July 7, 2021. Tournament Director may accept entries at the Bowling Center until start of each event (subject to space available).

9. Sanctioned Tournament and Applicable Rules:

This Tournament shall be conducted under USBC Rules, except for changes noted on this form. Any substitutes shall bowl full game.

Rules 314, 319a.5, will not apply.

Singles/Doubles/Team/ (All Events – Handicapped and/or Scratch)
\$22 per Person per Event + \$5.00 Optional All Events (each hdcp. and/or scratch)
(\$9.00 Lineage + \$2.25 Expenses + \$10.75 Prize Fund)

1. Eligibility:

Active SIR Members, those with SIR membership applications pending, guest of a SIR member (man or woman 50 years or older), wives of SIR members regardless of age. All entrants must be USBC sanctioned bowlers for the current season. Persons not eligible shall forfeit all bowling and prize money.

2. Participation:

- a) Singles: A bowler may bowl only one time.
- b) Doubles: A bowler may bowl and cash twice. At least one bowler in the lineup must be different.

ONE BOWLER MUST BE A SIR MEMBER.

- c) Team: A bowler may bowl and cash two times. At least two bowlers in the lineup must be different. TWO BOWLERS MUST BE SIR MEMBERS
- d) First score bowled in each event will count for All Events prize.

3. Handicap:

100% of 230 singles; 460 doubles; 920 team

4. Average:

- 2020-2021 USBC Standard Composite Average of 21 games or more.
- If none use USBC 2019-2020 Standard Composite Average of 21 games or more.
- If none, current league average of 21 games or more, must supply secretary signed current league sheet at check in.
- If none of these, bowler must use a 230 average (NO HANDICAP).
- 5) USBC Rule 319a. 1-4 will apply. (If any current league average of 21 games or more is 10 or more pins higher than submitted, you must declare).

5. Verification:

If averages (per this Tournament Rule 4) are on the USBC League Average site (Bowl.com), no further verification is required. Averages and USBC membership will be checked prior to start of tournament.

6. Divisions:

There will be three divisions: Divisions 1 and 2 will be divided by average after mail-in close of entries. Division 3 will be a Women's Division in SINGLES and ALL-EVENTS. No divisions in scratch All-Events.

7. Prize Fund:

Will be returned 100% on a ratio of at least 1 prize for each 4 entries.

8. Deadlines and Entry Requirements:

Reserve entries must be received by August 4, 2021.

Tournament Director may accept entries at the Bowling Center until start of each event (subject to space available).
