This golf event is open to all SIR golfers but limited to the first 112 golfers to sign up, after that a waiting list will be established. Registration for this event will open on Saturday August 19th. The registration form can be found on the golf website listed above. This event will use the same format as in prior years. There will be seven flights established by handicap index. Each flight will compete (Medal Play) to determine the winner of their flight who will then be awarded a commemorative jacket as 2023 Champion of their flight. There will also be a tournament prize fund with prizes awarded for the best net rounds of the day. Entry fee for this tournament is \$80 which includes golf, cart, range balls and prize fund.
