Secretary's Report

Secretary's report for the BEC meeting held on April 8, 2025 was presented by Secretary Jim Rodrigues. Since no additions or corrections were made, a motion to approve was made by Eddie Toews, seconded by Rick Bronner and approved by the board.

Treasurer's Reports

Treasurer John Salmon presented the following financial reports for our checking account for April and May:

April 2025. We had a beginning balance of \$13,685 and a month-ending balance of \$12,869. Cash on hand is \$150.00. General Fund Receipts: Dues \$240.00, Luncheon Profit \$173.00. Custodial Fund Receipts: Luncheon \$1,077.00, Badges \$40.00, LDL Ticket Sales \$1,995.00. General Fund Disbursements: Copies, Supplies, etc. \$53.00, Flyer Mailing \$15.00, Rent, S/U, C/U \$415.00, Second Quarter

Assessments \$333.00, Secretary Supplies \$17.00, B-day Free Lunch \$20.00, Sponsor Payout Free Lunches (2) \$40.00. Custodial Fund Disbursements: Luncheon 1,077.00, Badges (2) \$39.00, LDL Cash Prizes \$300.00, LDL Linen Rentals \$482.00, Deposit for Catering Summer Picnic \$1,400.00, Deposit for space @ Indigeny \$150.00.

May 2025. A beginning balance of \$12,869 and ending balance of \$10,352.00 was reported with a cash on hand of \$150.00. General Fund Receipts: Dues \$30.00, Raffle \$685.00. Custodial Fund Receipts: LDL Luncheon Tickets \$630.00, Badges for new members \$10.00. General Fund Disbursements: Rent, S/U, C/U \$415.00. Custodial Fund Disbursements: Luncheon \$3,451.00, Badges \$35.00, Frames for LDL Tables \$7.50, Extra LDL Linen \$30.00, Pictures for H & G Show \$29.00, Tablecloth for Picnic \$54.00. Treasurer John Salmon reported losses of approximately \$1,000.00 to \$1,500.00 yearly based on past financial records.

Motion to approve report made by Assistant Treasurer Eddie Toews and seconded by Big Sir Rick Bronner and approved by the board.

Big SIR Report - Rick Bronner

Rick Bronner brought up a motion to Donate \$200.00 to the Sonora Foothills Women's Club to support their efforts in table decorations for the LDL event. This motion was seconded by Marty Martin and approved by the board.

Eddie Toews Report

Eddie Toews reported on the Home and Garden Show which was a success in that we gained a possible 3 new members. Also, we shared a booth with the Twain Harte SIR Branch 172. The Ladies Day Luncheon was discussed: a total of 103 lunches were served and \$360.00 in tips was collected for the cooking crew. The raffle event was a big success

with 48 raffle prizes being donated and \$685.00 in raffle tickets being sold. Tickets for the August 21st Picnic are now on sale. Changes to the drink menu were discussed with a determination to be addressed at next month's final pre-picnic meeting. Members were asked to bring tables if needed.

Little Sir Report

Rick Bronner updated the medical report on Mike Krom noting that the guest speaker arrangements would have to be made by the BEC Members for the near future.

Attendance/Membership Report

Eddie Toews reported that 2 new members were added during June to bring our month-ending balance total to 118.

Activities Reports

Rick Bronner reported that the Summer Bowling League was in full swing. The Father's Day Fly-In was discussed with an emphasis on the parking issue. Rick to place flyers at each table today highlighting the Car Show at the Fly-In.
