May:

We had a beginning balance of \$11,420.60 and a month-end balance of \$8,258.01, Cash on hand is \$150.00. General Fund Receipts: Dues \$30.00, Raffle \$665.00. Custodial Fund Receipts: Luncheon Tickets \$280.00, Badge for new member \$10.00. General Fund Disbursements: Domain Registration \$20.17, Rent, S/U, C/U \$415.00, A/V Equipment \$139.06. Custodial Fund Disbursements: LDL Catering \$2,800.00, Linens \$393.36, Prize Money \$300.00, Ticket Refund \$80.00.
